Author Guideline Tab for IJAITR



- 1. **Originality and Prior Publication:** All submitted papers must be original and have not been published previously. Simultaneous submissions to other journals or publications are not allowed. Authors must disclose any prior presentations or publications of the material at various stages of its evolution, such as workshops, conferences, or journals.
- 2. **Submission Disclosure:** Authors are required to disclose any prior submissions of the same paper to other journals or publications. This includes providing information about any overlap with previously published work, whether by the same authors or others. Full transparency regarding the status and history of the submitted work is essential.
- 3. **Multiple Submissions:** Submission of the same paper to multiple journals simultaneously is not allowed. Authors should commit to submitting their work exclusively to the IJAITR journal and inform the journal promptly if the paper is accepted elsewhere during the review process.
- 4. **Plagiarism:** Plagiarism, defined as the use of someone else's ideas, processes, results, or words without proper acknowledgment, is strictly prohibited. Authors must ensure that their submissions are free from plagiarism, and any use of external content must be appropriately cited.
- 5. **Guidelines for Artificial Intelligence (AI)-Generated Text:** Any content generated by artificial intelligence (AI) used in a paper shall be disclosed in the acknowledgments section. Authors must identify the AI system used and provide a brief explanation of its usage.
- 6. **Authorship and Acknowledgments:** All listed authors must have made significant contributions to the research presented in the paper. Proper acknowledgment of the contributions of others should be included in the paper. Authors should declare any conflicts of interest and provide appropriate acknowledgment for funding sources.
- 7. **Copyright and Permissions:** Authors must ensure that they have the right to submit the paper for consideration and publication. If the paper includes material that requires permission for use, authors are responsible for obtaining such permissions and must provide evidence of this during the submission process.
- 8. **Compliance with Journal Guidelines:** Authors must adhere to the specific guidelines provided by the journal regarding formatting, structure, and other submission

- requirements. Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in the rejection of the submission.
- 9. **Ethical Conduct:** Authors are expected to conduct their research and present their findings with the highest ethical standards. Any ethical concerns or conflicts of interest should be disclosed to the journal editors during the submission process.

To enable the publisher to protect the copyright of the journal, authors must sign copyright in their manuscripts to the publisher. all submitted manuscripts must be accompanied by a statement signed by all authors that the article is original, is not under consideration by another journal, has not previously been published elsewhere and its content has not been anticipated by any previous publication
